

# Genesis 3:8-15 Good News Translation

<sup>8</sup> That evening they heard the LORD God walking in the garden, and they hid from him among the trees. <sup>9</sup> But the LORD God called out to the man, "Where are you?"

<sup>10</sup> He answered, "I heard you in the garden; I was afraid and hid from you, because I was naked."

<sup>11</sup> "Who told you that you were naked?" God asked. "Did you eat the fruit that I told you not to eat?"

<sup>12</sup> The man answered, "The woman you put here with me gave me the fruit, and I ate it."

<sup>13</sup> The LORD God asked the woman, "Why did you do this?"

She replied, "The snake tricked me into eating it."

<sup>14</sup> Then the LORD God said to the snake, "You will be punished for this; you alone of all the animals must bear this curse: From now on you will crawl on your belly, and you will have to eat dust as long as you live. <sup>15</sup> I will make you and the woman hate each other; her offspring and yours will always be enemies. Her offspring will crush your head, and you will bite her offspring's heel."

# 2 Corinthians 4:13-5:1 Good News Translation

<sup>13</sup> The scripture says, "I spoke because I believed." In the same spirit of faith we also speak because we believe. <sup>14</sup> We know that God, who raised the Lord Jesus to life, will also raise us up with Jesus and take us, together with you, into his presence. <sup>15</sup> All this is for your sake; and as God's grace reaches more and more people, they will offer to the glory of God more prayers of thanksgiving.

<sup>16</sup> For this reason we never become discouraged. Even though our physical being is gradually decaying, yet our spiritual being is renewed day after day. <sup>17</sup> And this small and temporary trouble we suffer will bring us a tremendous and eternal glory, much greater than the trouble. <sup>18</sup> For we fix our attention, not on things that are seen, but on things that are unseen. What can be seen lasts only for a time, but what cannot be seen lasts forever.

**5** For we know that when this tent we live in—our body here on earth—is torn down, God will have a house in heaven for us to live in, a home he himself has made, which will last forever.
